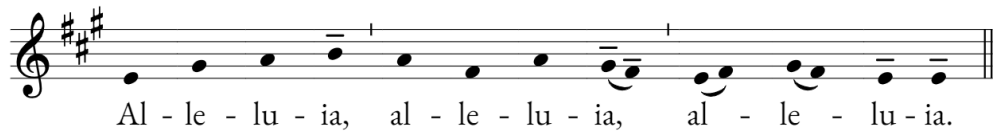

Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed

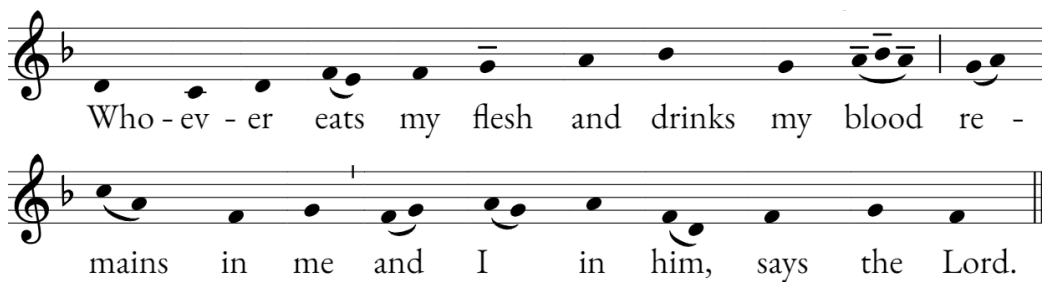
