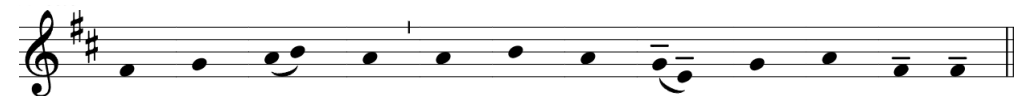

Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed

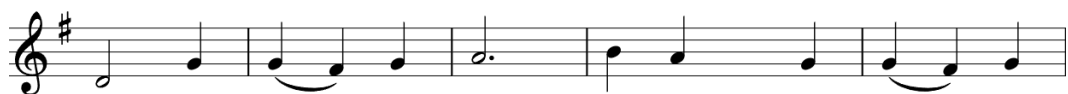

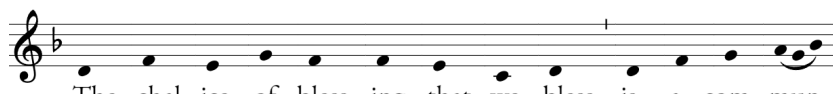

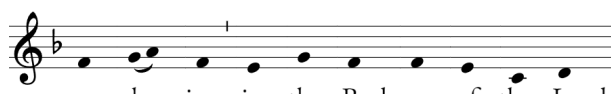
