Pentecost Sequence – *Veni, Sancte Spiritus*

Following the ancient custom of the Church, a special hymn to the Holy Spirit is prayed prior to the proclaiming of Gospel on the Solemnity of Pentecost.

Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed
